Please mark all clothing and items with first and last names. Please pack enough clothing for the duration of the trip as laundry facilities are not available.

Note: Clothing WILL get dirty! Pack swimsuits and towel on top as all participants will need to quickly change on Day 1 for the Float Test which is during Orientation.
